## Deborah Berke's Latest Readies for Its Debut

New York architecture and design firm <u>Deborah Berke Partners</u> brings its vision to Lower Manhattan with its first downtown tower. With units starting at \$1.295 million, <u>77 Greenwich</u> emphasizes warm minimalism through natural materials and expert craftsmanship.

The 42-story tower soars above Battery Park, with a pleated glass-curtain-wall façade designed by FXCollaborative providing water views from each of the 90 residences, which begin on the 15th floor. Retail space, ample amenities, and an elementary school on the ground floor solidify 77 Greenwich's appeal to FiDi workers looking to trade their commute for a work-live hybrid.
